  - d) Bidder and/or any of its allied entity(ies), which directly or indirectly control(s) or is(are) controlled by o r is(are) under common control of another entity, has(ve) participated as a consultant in the preparati on of the design or technical specifications of the contract that is the subject of the tender; or
  - e) Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process.
  - f) In cases of agents quoting on behalf of their principal manufacturers/service providers, one agent can not represent two manufacturers/service providers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry.
