1. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
2. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Turnover shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
3. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023.

4. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

If the buyer has mentioned MSE purchase preference in ATC then service provider is required to upload necessary documents for MSE purchase preference for verification by the buyer during evaluation.

## 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be  $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$ , subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

**a) Eligibility Criteria:** Under Make In India directives, only Class-I / II supplier of Misch Metal having minimum local content of 20% is allowed to participate in this tender. Vendors are requested to indicate the same clearly as per declaration asked in GOI order (Public Procurement (preference to make in India), order dtd 04.06.2020, revision dated 19/07/2024). Vendors having minimum 20% local content as per the above policy will be eligible to participate, however for purchase preference, Class-I vendor will be considered with minimum 50% local content in line of the above policy and revision if any.

b) Inspection: Materials conforming to the specifications as mentioned in the technical specification should be supplied. Analysis of material will be done at ASP after receipt of material. Materials not conforming to the order specification and found on analysis beyond the penalty limits specified as under shall stand rejected and supplier shall replace the material free of cost on DDP plant stores basis. Penalty Limits & financial deduction for acceptance of materials found beyond the order specification –

Rejection: Materials conforming to the specifications mentioned in the Order (as per chemical parameters and size stated), only should be supplied. Materials not conforming to the order shall stand rejected. Analysis of material will be done at ASP, Durgapur after receipt of material. On analysis at ASP, Materials not found to the order specification ( i.e. within acceptable Range even with penalty) , shall stand rejected and supplier shall replace the material free of cost on DDP plant stores basis Supplier must remove the rejected goods within specified time period by respective SAIL plants .

c) During sample collection, supplier's representatives may be present. Details procedure for sample collection & testing will be as per SAIL [SPFA: 2014](#) attached herewith.

d) Payment Term:- Payment will be made directly to seller bank account as per details on GeM considering final analysis at ASP & working out deductions for built in penalty as above & other deductions as applicable. Test Certificate should indicate composition and analysis of all elements & size. Delivery beyond scheduled period is to be made only on specific clearance from ASP (even in case with LD).

Supplier will send dispatch details & other documents including GST Invoice on offline mode i.e directly to ASP. Testing will be done at ASP RCL through XRF / wet method as per facility available at ASP. All other modalities including LD, time frame, payment etc. shall be as per GTC of GeM. Test certificate should indicate composition and analysis of all elements and size. Sampling in presence of supplier authorized representative & and retesting etc will be done as per prevailing standard SAIL procedure SPFA: 2014 attached herewith.

e) Mode of Dispatch: Material shall be dispatched by road in top open trucks on full truck load basis directly from supplier's works to ASP Durgapur. All consignment should be properly covered with water proof Tarpauline and tightly held using strong ropes from all sides. The seller shall be responsible for making all transportation arrangements at their risk and cost on door delivery basis for timely supply of materials to meet the delivery schedule. **Unloading at ASP stores will be arranged by ASP.**

**Weighment :** All the trucks shall be weighed at destination at ASP's Weighbridge(s) . If the weighment at ASP for that truck is within tolerance range of minus 0.5 percent of the Supplier's Challan weight, The supplier's challan weight shall be final. If the weighment at ASP is found to be more than the Challan weight, the payment shall be restricted up to the Challan weight. In case the weighment at ASP is found to be less by more than 0.5 percent of the challan weight, the weighment found at ASP shall be final for the purpose of payment.

f) SAIL, the company reserves its right to remove from the list of 'Approved vendor' or to ban business dealing, if any agency is found to have committed misconduct and also to suspend business dealing pending investigation. Banned /suspended firms/ suppliers etc are not eligible for submission of quotation against the tender during the period of suspension /banned and if submitted , those offers will be treated as Unsolicited & will not be considered.

g) Regular performance on quality and delivery will be monitored and vendor rating will be done as per ISO procedure. Suppliers below cut off mark will be downgraded to Potential vendor and will be considered for trial order only.

h) Whenever under this contract any sum of money is recoverable from and payable by the Supplier, the Purchaser shall be entitled to recover such sum by appropriating, in part or whole the security deposited by the Supplier, if a security is taken against the contract being insufficient or if no security has been taken from the Supplier, then the balance or the sum recoverable, as the case may be, shall be deducted from any sum when due or which at any time thereafter may become due to the Supplier under this or any other contract with the Purchaser / Company. Should this sum be not sufficient to cover the full amount recoverable the Supplier shall pay to the Purchaser / Company on demand the remaining balance due.

i) Conciliation and Arbitration:- At Durgapur as per GeM standard Terms & Conditions.

j) Legal Jurisdiction:- All suits and legal proceedings by or against steel plant in any matter arising out of the tender shall be triable only by the appropriate civil court at the place where steel plants are located.

**k) Risk Purchase** - If the supplier fails to deliver the stores either in full or in part, within the prescribed delivery period, the Purchaser shall be entitled at his option to take alternate procurement action, at the risk & cost of the supplier for the unsupplied portion of the goods/items for which delivery has expired without cancelling the contract in respect of stores not yet due for delivery, or to cancel the contract based on progress of work , including stores not due for delivery, and, if thought fit/ necessary, to purchase the stores at the risk and cost of the supplier. The price differential in case of higher cost to SAIL, If any, shall have to be borne by the defaulting supplier. Moreover the defaulting supplier shall have no claim over the quantity, which they failed to supply.

**l) Banning of Business Dealings:** On arising any situation or occurrence of any event as mentioned in Clause 6 of the Guidelines on Banning of Business Dealings (as per SAIL guidelines enclosed in ATC), the tenderer/bidder or supplier under the tendering process or contract with SAIL, as the case may be, shall be li

able for action under and in accordance with the aforementioned Guidelines. The "Guidelines on Banning of Business Dealings" shall form part of the Tender/Contract

#### 4. **Certificates**

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

#### 7. **Generic**

Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Seller, if:

- i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.
- ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
- iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.
- iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
- v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
- vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
- vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.



4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

**All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.**
