Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
- 2. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:
 - i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
 - ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
 - iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
 - iv. If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1
 - v. If L-1 is non-MII and H-1 is eligible MII and H-1 price is coming within price band of 20% of Non-MII L-1

If the buyer has mentioned MSE purchase preference in ATC then service provider is required to upload necessary documents for MSE purchase preference for verification by the buyer during evaluation.

- 1. Delivery is tentative, Actual delivery is 120 Days from PO date or QAP & Drawing Approval date whichever is later.
- 2. Vendors have to submit QAP for approval of BHEL within 15 days of PO da te. Resubmission of QAP, if required, has to be done within 10 days of comments from BHEL. Contractual delivery for LD purpose shall be re-fixed from date of QAP approval after deducting delay on vendor's part, if any, in submission/resubmission of OAP.
- 3. Payment terms as- 100% payment within 90 days (45 days for MSE & 60 days for Medium enterprise) of receipt of material subject to acceptance of material at BHEL. As per order F. No. 1(2)(1)/ 2016-MA dated 09/02/2017 from Min. of MSME traders/agents are not allowed for benefits/relaxations extended to MSEs.
- 4. Material to be properly protected to avoid any transit damage.
- 5. Evaluation of offers shall be done w.r.t. tender requirement(Drawing, Mat erial Specification, PQR. Offers of bidders having technical/ commercial devi ations, which are not acceptable to BHEL, shall be rejected before price bid opening.
- 6. Invoice, Test Certificate and Guarantee Certificate to be uploaded after s upply on SUVIDHA Portal (https://suvidha.bhel.in/suvidha/) It will be mandat ory to register their invoices (Digitally signed) exclusively through the SUVI DHA Portal along with the required documents. - 9. Vendor to submit signed and sealed copy of Specification and Techno Commercial documents along with bid for compliance.
- 10. Breach of Contract, Remedies and Termination- In case of breach of cont ract, BHEL may resort to recover 10% of the total contract value through va rious financial remedies such as security instruments like Performance Bank Guarantee, bills of the supplier, retention amount etc. with BHEL or opt for I egal remedies. Further, levy of liquidated damages, debarment, termination , de- scoping, short-closure, etc. shall be applied as per provisions of the contract.

- 11. In case of trader or dealer, Bidder to furnish authorization certificate from their Manufacturer/OEM for evaluation of offer.
- 12. Unless covered under Force Majeure conditions aforesaid, Penalty for lat e delivery shall be 0.5% of the undelivered portion per week of delay or part thereof, subject to a maximum of 10% of the undelivered order value owing to delayed delivery . Total undelivered order value above shall be item wise, lot wise order value of PO.
- 13. If any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clause s or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid d etails field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM.
- 14. For this item, applicable GST rate@18% and Cess rate @Zero% for GST r egistered firm/bidder. As cess is not applicable to this item, hence it is man datory to quote Cess rate @Zero%. Cess rate other than @Zero% is liable t o be rejected at any stage of tender even after price bid.
