A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti- competitive practices to the detriment of Employer's interests. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:

- a) they directly or indirectly control, or are controlled by or are under common control of another entity; or
- b) they have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of their bids: or
- c) they have relationship with each other, directly or through common t hird party(ies), that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another Bidder; or
- d) Bidder and/or any of its allied entity(ies), which directly or indirectly c ontrol(s) or is(are) controlled by or is(are) under common control of ano ther entity, has(ve) participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the contract that is the subject of the tender; or
- e) Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process.
- f) In cases of agents quoting on behalf of their principal manufacturers/ service providers, one agent cannot represent two manufacturers/servi ce providers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry.
