Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

If the buyer has mentioned MSE purchase preference in ATC then service provider is required to upload necessary documents for MSE purchase preference for verification by the buyer during evaluation.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. **Generic**

Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

3. **Generic**

Bidders shall quote only those products (Part of Service delivery) in the bid which are not obsolete in the market and has at least 1 years residual market life i.e. the offered product shall not be declared end-of-life by the OEM before this period.

4. **Generic**

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

5. **Generic**

Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

- a. Copy of PAN Card.
- b. Copy of GSTIN.
- c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
- d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.

6. **Generic**

Data Sheet of the product(s) offered in the bid, are to be uploaded along with the bid documents. Buyers can match and verify the Data Sheet with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplained mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.

7. **Scope of Supply**

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods

8. **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1. The item shall be supplied as per the specification is enclosed. Deviation in specification if any may be separately indicated in Form 2.
2. The bidder shall offer the price on "F.O.R Salem Steel Plant" basis in GeM portal including P&F charges, Freight & Insurance Charges etc with applicable taxes & duties.
3. The payment shall be "100% within 30 days after receipt and acceptance of the item at Salem Steel Plant Stores".
4. Unless otherwise specified in the tender terms, the inspection will be at Salem Steel Plant after receipt of the consignment.
5. The bidder shall not quote/attach any price/price bid format along with their technical offer. The offer of such bidder will be summarily rejected.
6. The MSE preference's shall only be given to bidders subject to submission/verification of valid Udyam Certificate.
7. The prices shall be kept firm till supplies are completed.

8. The bidder shall enclose signed and sealed copy of the technical specification along with the tender document, as a token of acceptance to the tendered item's specification and term and conditions.
9. Delivery Schedule: : Within 24 weeks. First lot: 20% of the order quantity to be supplied within 04 weeks .Next lot should be supplied in staggered manner: Approximately 16% of the order quantity every month or as per SSP's production requirement.
10. In normal course order shall be placed on single source. However, quantity is divisible in case of MSE preference.
11. Quantity Tolerance : As per GEM +/- 25%
12. Supply Tolerance : +10%/-5%
13. The applicable EMD amount for Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five Thousand Only). However, bidders can submit "Bid Securing Declaration" in lieu of EMD, duly signed & sealed.
14. Kindly submit duly filled-in copies of consolidated undertaking, acceptance forms, .i.e. Eligibility criteria forms, Declarations for Specification and terms & Conditions and Land border certificate (Form 1 to Form 5).
15. Kindly confirm compliance towards documents submission as per the check list attached.
16. Kindly accept and confirm commercial terms, general terms & conditions and all other terms of the RFQ.
17. The successful bidder should furnish security deposit in the form of bank guarantee, for an amount covering 3% (three percent) of the order value of the contract within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of order placement.
18. In case of delay in submission of security deposit, a penalty of 0.2% of the original SD amount per completed day of delay, limited to an amount not exceeding 5% of the original SD amount shall be applicable. payment for executed portion of order should only commence on submission of requisite SD.
19. Security deposit -Bank guarantee will be applicable after order placement. Format is attached.
20. **Security Deposit:** Security Deposit for an amount covering 3% (three) of the basic value (excluding taxes, duties & freight) of the contract, has to be submitted by supplier within fifteen days (twenty one days for overseas suppliers) of the date of purchase order, separately at each of the sail units for which orders are placed.
 - a. Security deposit can be submitted either in the form of demand draft / pay order / banker's cheque or bank guarantee issued by any scheduled commercial bank other than co-operative and Gramin bank. the demand drafts/ pay order/ banker's cheque should be payable at the respective sail unit. BGS should be from banks having branch at respective sail unit and endorsed by the corresponding local bank at SAIL/SSP as per performa enclosed.
 - b. Bank guarantee shall be submitted as per performa enclosed along with the tender. the stamp paper used for the bank guarantee shall be of the appropriate value and should be purchased on or after the date of placement of order. the stamp paper used for the bank guarantee should be purchased on behalf of the issuing bank and is suance of amendment / extension of bank guarantee should also be made on stamp paper of appropriate value purchased in the name of the bank. contact details and address of the issuing branch must be available in the Bank Guarantee.
 - c. In case security deposit is submitted in the form of Bank Guarantee, then manufacturer shall ensure that bank guarantee is to be submitted by the issuing bank directly to respective sail unit by registered post with A/D/ courier marked to contact given in purchase order.
 - d. Failure for submission of Security Deposit: Failure to submit security deposit within the period specified, will constitute a breach of the contract and purchaser shall be entitled to forfeit the EMD and to take alternate procurement action at the risk and cost of the supplier.
 - e. Interest-no claim shall lie against SAIL/SSP either in respect of interest on security

- deposit or depreciation in value.
- f. The Security Deposit Bank Guarantee (SDBG) shall be kept valid and in full force and effect till a period of three months from the date of delivery of the last consignment of the purchase order. the SDBG shall be operable at the local branches of issuing bank located at the respective sail plants.
 - g. Return of BG -on due performance and completion of the contract in all respects, security deposit shall be returned to the supplier without any interest.
 - h. In case the supplier delays submission of security deposit, a penalty of 0.2% of the original SD amount per completed day of delay, limited to an amount not exceeding 5% of the original SD / BG amount shall be applicable. payment for executed portion of order shall commence on submission of requisite SD.
21. The bidder shall submit the required documents sought under the "Eligibility Criteria" for evaluation of their offer and declarations to be furnished in the checklist as per forms.
 22. SSP reserves the option to increase or decrease the RFQ quantity and divert the order quantity to other sources, if supply is not made as per schedule stipulated in the purchase order or on account of quantity complaints. In such instances the extra cost incurred, if any will be recovered from the defaulting supplier.
 23. By participating in this tender, the Suppliers/Vendors/Customers are deemed to have undertaken that they shall not give or take any financial or non-financial bribe, to or from anyone during the tender or during the execution of the contract, thereafter and if they notice any such incident happening, they shall report to Sail Vigilance.
 24. "Salem Steel Plant is registered on TREDS Platform with invoicemart.com (<https://www.invoicement.com/>). MSE Vendors may avail this benefit.

अस्वीकरण/Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.

11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.
