6. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

3. Generic

Manufacturer Authorization:Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid

4. Scope of Supply

1. Seller agrees that he/she has read and understood the technical specifications and features of **Vehicle Mount X-Ray Baggage Inspection System (Including Vehicle)** uploaded as buyer added ATC document.
2. The following additional features shall form of the offered XBIS:
 - a) The vehicle should be proportional to the size of XBIS.
 - b) There should be proper cooling and heating system with sufficient space for operators and proper earthing system for smooth functioning of the XBIS.
 - c) The overall size of vehicle should be appropriate dimensions keeping in view the field requirement as some venues are not so spacious for installation of large size of vehicle mounted XBIS.
 - d) The power source in the form of Genset should be of sufficient capacity to cater the requirements of the XBIS and allied accessories. The Genset should be installed at appropriate space inside the vehicle so that it may not affect the monitoring system and is on channel based trolley for pulling out during operation, besides, maintaining proper temperature inside the vehicle.

3. Wherever there is any conflict between GeM parameters and buyer added bid specific ATC parameters, the clauses mentioned in later i.e. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC shall supersede and remain applicable.

8. If the successful bidder fails to supply the goods of the prescribed specification or fails to deliver the goods within stipulated period as specifically mentioned in the supply order, the department shall be at liberty to arrange supplies by re-bidding or otherwise at the risk and cost of the bidder. The department shall be lawfully entitled to forfeit the amount of the EMD/security money and take penal action to make good the loss sustained or excess cost incurred by the state in arranging of the supplies and other remedies that may be available with the department, under law.
9. **Late Delivery:** In case of delayed delivery, the Seller shall pay to the Buyer for every 1 weeks of delay penalty amounting to 0.5% of the total value of the equipment whose delivery has been delayed. Any fractional part of a week is to be considered a full week.
10. All legal proceedings arising out of any dispute between the parties shall have to be settled in the Courts situated in Srinagar and Jammu and not elsewhere.
11. Conditional bid will not be accepted / entertained. It will be summarily rejected. No other conditions than those mentioned (in the terms set-forth) will be entertained.

While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws./जेम की सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास पंजीकृत हो। बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।
