1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific Scope Of Work(SOW)

- 1. Special Conditions of Contract
- 1. 1 Introduction & Background

National High-Speed Rail Corporation Limited (NHSRCL), having its site office at 1001-1006, 10th Floor Sw astik Universal Building Tower-A Wing-B Rundh Surat-395007, Gujarat, which is a joint sector enterprise of Central Government and State Government of participating states under the provisions of companies act. I nvites bids for hiring of vehicle in Gujarat under office of CPM/Electrical/Surat for the official use for a perio d of 2 (two) years.

1.2 Scope of Work

All the vehicles (running on diesel/petrol fuel only) preferably be registered in Gujarat to avoid any inconv enience. In case, vehicles are registered outside Gujarat, then the successful bidder should be responsible for paying full road tax to state govt. authority along with fulfilment of other statuary compliance before de ploying vehicles to NHSRCL. All vehicles should bear a yellow colour registration number plate (commercia l license).

The actual deployment (addition and removal of vehicles) of the vehicles will be decided by NHSRCL and w ill be intimated to the bidder separately at least 01 (one) week prior. Hence, this should be kept in mind by the bidders while submitting the bid.

- 1.3 All the vehicles to be provided by the successful bidder should be in good condition and should be mec hanically sound. The vehicle will have to be fitted/provided with decent interiors including Air conditioner, clean seat covers, working graphical positioning system, Seat Belts (Front & Rear), First Aid box and Umbr ella during Monsoon and tissue paper etc. as and when required. Vehicle should be in perfectly sound cond ition and suitable for use by Senior Officers. Tenderer should note that above mentioned list is only indicative and not exhaustive.
- 1.4 It is to be noted that extra hours and extra kilometre's will be calculated on quarterly basis. Means, the average in a quarter will be taken for the calculation of extra kilometre and extra hour for each hired vehic le separately.
- 1.5 Successful Bidder should provide 24 hrs. contact number (mobile phone) on which such information ca

n be given. Further, the successful bidder should provide driver with a mobile phone having both incoming & outgoing facilities at his own cost.

- 1.6 The base station for the deployment of vehicle can be Surat/Vadodara/Bharuch/Navsari/Valsad/ Dadra and Nagar Haveli and the vehicle can be used anywhere in Gujarat and Maharashtra state and Dadra and Nagar Haveli. No extra payment shall be made for usage of vehicle in Gujarat and Dadra and Nagar Haveli as this is the local definition as per NHSRCL.
- 1.7 The successful bidder should note that once the vehicle has been deployed to NHSRCL, the bidder can not withdrawal/change the vehicle without the prior approval of CPM/Electrical/Surat. If the successful bidd er fails to comply this condition, the tender likely to be terminated by giving 30 days' notice period to the contractor.
- 1.8 The contractor shall be completely responsible for the safe running of the vehicle. NHSRCL will not be r esponsible for any loss, damage, repairs, maintenance or accident to the vehicle or driver. NHSRCL will not provide any compensation in case of accidents, causalities etc.
- 1.9 Contractor shall have to maintain logbook by officer-in-charge which shall have to be filled daily and pr esented to NHSRCL's authorized representative for signature. Every day the initial kilometre reading to be recorded in logbook is when the vehicle placed at nominated place for usage of NHSRCL official at site or r esidence. Similarly, the closing kilometre reading should be when the official leaves the vehicle at site, res idence or office. No payment shall be made for any extra movement to and fro from garage/parking place or any other used by driver etc.
- 1.10 NHSRCL will not take any responsibility of parking space of any kind for the vehicles hired. Parking ch arges and Toll tax charges, if incurred during the onsite duty shall be reimbursed/paid on submission of do cumentary evidence as admissible as per applicable Rules & Provisions.
- 1.11 Payment of hiring charges will be made on monthly basis on submission of bill and after the due verification of log books by the NHSRCL official.
- 1.12 The contractor shall give consent for receipt of payment through RTGS/ECS/NEFT. Charges if any will be on account of the contractor. The contractor shall provide all the details like Name of the bank, Address of the bank, branch code, IFSC code of the bank, Type of the account, Account no., contact no. for account related queries etc.
- 1.13 NHSRCL in no case is responsible for any legal matter arising of any state/central govt. laws in matter of employment of the driver by owner of the vehicle or in respect of any other matter.
- 1.14 NHSRCL reserves the right to close the Contract at any time without assigning any reasons thereat by giving a 30 days' notice. Contractor shall not be entitled for any compensation in such eventuality.
- 1.15 Minimum 50% vehicles should be owned by the successful bidder in his name (if proprietor) or company's name.
- 1.16 During the currency of contract, vehicle cannot be used for any other purpose except for NHSRCL.
- 1.17 The Contractor should submit the details and documents of the vehicle provided to this office immedi ately on receipt of acceptance letter. The vehicle documents submitted should clearly mention the date of purchase, make, model, registration no. Chassis No., type of fuel i.e. Diesel/Petrol. The agreement will be considered operated from the date from which the vehicle is actually pressed into service.
- 1.18 The vehicle provided to NHSRCL must be fully and comprehensively insured covering the risk to the d river and all the passengers also. The Insurance shall protect the contractor and NHSRCL against all risk, cl aims for loss, Injuries, disability, disease and death of members of public including NHSRCL men and dama ge to the property of others arising from the use of vehicle during operations respective of the ownership of such vehicle.
- 1.19 Drivers deployed shall be skilled, well behaved, well dressed us Instructed by officer-in charge holdin g valid tourist driving license, and capable of undertaking minor repairs of vehicles. All papers should be r eadily available with the vehicles like registration, PUC, permit for running the vehicles in Gujarat and Dadr a and Nagar Haveli, etc. Vehicles should be insured against accident as per rules and statutory obligations, certificate towards road tax etc. Driver shall be able to produce relevant documents as and when requisitioned from him. Consequences of failure to comply with any rules and regulation of the concerned authorities shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor.
- 1.20 Driver should have adequate amount with him during the travel for emergency repairs parking, filling

of diesel/Petrol, oil/etc. The contractor should provide fast-tag to the driver for payment of toll tax.

- 1.21 Driver should never be under the influence of alcohol during Duty hours. Contractor shall replace the driver permanently in case of non-compliance.
- 1.22 Contractor must submit the "POLICE VERIFICATION of the driver within 15 days after issue of Letter of Acceptance.
- 1.23 NHSRCL will not provide any accommodation to driver while on duty/Night Stay. Driver himself shall a rrange Boarding / Lodging. In case, the reporting place of duty is located far off, necessary arrangement in the nearby areas will be made by Contractor / service provider for housing of driver and parking of the veh icle so that the same is available at short notice.
- 1.24 The base station of the vehicle would be decided by NHSRCL from time to time.
- 1.25 The driver must carry a photo identify card provided by the Contractor/service provider.
- 1.26 Applicable taxes shall be deducted at source as per extent rules, while processing the bill.
- 1.27 Speedometer and kilometre recorder shall be maintained to high standard/ accuracy. Any defect noti ced shall be rectified immediately. NHSRCL reserves the right to get the meter calibrated or checked at an y time at its sole discretion. Tempering/manipulation of meter reading and misbehaviour of driver shall be viewed seriously. Penalty will be imposed as per penalty clause. In case of repeat of tempering, NHSRCL m ay even decide to terminate the contract and forfeiture of security deposit in the event of any error/fault in the meter being noticed, NHSRCL reserves the right to adjust the bill for the journey undertaken (including those undertaken earlier) besides any other penal action. The kilometres verified by official using the vehicle shall be final and binding.
- 1.28 The successful bidder must ensure payment of wages to the driver as per Minimum Wages Act. The s uccessful bidder must note that non-compliance may lead to termination of contract. Successful bidder is r equired to pay Salaries / wages of contracted staff deployed at buyer location first i.e. on their own and th en claim payment from Buyer along with production of proof of all statutory documents like, PF, ESIC etc al ong with the bill as well as the bank statement of payment done to contracted staff deployed at buyer loca tion on monthly basis.
- 1.29 The rates quoted by the bidder shall be inclusive of all major/minor repairs/maintenance, servicing of vehicles, cost of fuel, lubricants and any other consumables, driver's salary & allowances required from ti me to time, duties, levies & Insurance charges for Inspection certificates, Incidental charges, penalties etc. as imposed by central/state local govt. bodies for running of vehicle.
- 1.30 The contract can be terminated at any time on account of unsatisfactory services upon review of performance by CPM/Electrical/Surat. The unsatisfactory service shall mean and include non- compliance and non-fulfilment of any of the contractual obligations by the service provider or poor performance or violation of any of the terms and conditions of the tender/contract and failure on its part to correct the discrepancies/ shortcomings, brought to pats notice in writing by CPM/Electrical/Surat.

1.31 ESCALATION / DE-ESCALATION FOR DIESEL/Petrol:

The price Escalation / De-escalation on account of increase / decrease in cost of fuel (Diesel/Petrol) shall be payable / recoverable on regular basis for each bill submitted by the Bidder. The rate of price escalation shall be the difference in cost of fuel on the last date of the month of travel and the base price i.e. the rate prevailing on final due date of submission of the bid.

Conversely recoveries shall be applicable for any decrease in fuel cost from the bills payable to the Bidder on the same basis of the applicable price reduction with respect to base price.

The price per litre shall be price charged by the petrol pumps including all taxes and levies. Bidder shall h ave to submit the documentary evidence of increase/decrease in fuel cost in the form of newspaper cuttin g, petrol pump bill etc. The average mileage/ fuel consumption shall be @ 15 KM per litre for Diesel/Petrol car. The Total escalation / De-escalation payable shall be for total KM. The basis for calculation of the varia tion in Diesel/Petrol prices shall be as:

Diesel/Petrol price Variation in Rs. Per Km = {(New diesel/petrol Price in Rs per Litre) - (Diesel/Petrol Price on date of Award)}/(Mileage in Km per Litre for Vehicle). No other escalation like increase in price of spare s, mobiles, lubricants etc. shall be payable other than that for Diesel price variation.

3. Payment

PAYMENT OF SALARIES AND WAGES: Service Provider is required to pay Salaries / wages of contracted staff deployed at buyer location first i.e. on their own and then claim payment from Buyer alongwith all statutory documents like, PF, ESIC etc. as well as the bank statement of payment done to staff.

- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for <u>attached categories</u>, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.

- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
- 16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
- 17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.
